**Divisions:** Elementary A grades 1-3 (comments only) 5-minute limit

Elementary B grades 4-6 5-minute limit
Intermediate grades 7-9 8-minute limit
High School grades 10-12 15-minute limit

**Date:** Saturday, November 11, 2023

**Enrollment:** Entry postmark deadline is October 11, 2023. Use the enrollment form provided. Late entries will not be accepted. Mail entries to:

**Fee:** The enrollment fee of \$25.00, \$30.00, or \$35.00 (and non-member entry fee, as applicable) must be included with the completed entry form.

## **Rules for the 2023 Concerto Auditions**

- The teacher must reside in the state of Kansas. Collegiate MTNA members may enter students in the Concerto audition.
- Students (including students of the Auditions Committee) are eligible for awards.
- Students play by memory. Each contestant must furnish their own accompanist and a copy of the music for the judge.
- Students may play repertoire which is not on the list or is out of print. The teacher must contact the committee chair for approval.

## Rules for Concerto Auditions, continued

- Students may play any repertoire, but must compete in their own school grade level. Students must play repertoire that is listed in their division or a higher division in order to win. Students may play repertoire at a lower level for evaluation only.
- Traditionally, three entries from each of the competition levels will be selected as finalists.
- Honorable mention awards will be given at the judges' discretion. Students performing for comments only are eligible for Honorable Mention.
- A first place winner will be chosen from each level:
  - Elementary B (grades 4-6)
  - Intermediate (grades 7-9)
  - High School (grades 10-12)
  - (Elementary A does not compete, but plays for comments only.)
- The winner of the High School division will be named the overall winner and will perform with the Friends University Community Orchestra on their spring concert.
- First place winners may <u>not</u> compete again for awards until they are eligible for the next division. They may play for comments.
- WMMTA policy: WMMTA will pay up to \$400.00 for rental or purchase, whichever is the lesser cost, of orchestral parts for the high school winner's performance. Any rental or purchase cost in excess of \$400.00 is the responsibility of the winner and/or his/her parents or guardian.
- It is the responsibility of the entrant to check the posted results of the preliminary auditions and to be present for the final audition if he/she is a finalist.
- Teachers of the winning finalists form the Concerto Audition Committee for the following year. Traditionally, the teacher of the high school winner serves as chair.
- Teachers of auditioning students will be expected to work at registration and as monitors on audition day.
