**Auditions:** Sponsored by Wichita Metropolitan Music Teachers Association. Members are eligible to enter students. Non-members of WMMTA may enter students by paying \$25.00 per entry, in addition to the student entry fee.

<b>Divisions:</b> Elementary A	grades 1-3 (comments only)	5 minute time limit
Elementary B	grades 4-6	5 minute time limit
Intermediate	grades 7-9	8 minute time limit
High School	grades 10-12	15 minute time limit

**Fee:** The enrollment fee of \$25.00, \$30.00, or \$35.00 (and non-member entry fee, as applicable) must be included with the completed entry form.

### Rules for the 2019 Concerto Auditions

1. The teacher must be a resident of the Wichita metropolitan area. Collegiate MTNA members may enter students in the Concerto audition.
2. Students of the Auditions committee are eligible for awards.
3. Students must furnish their own accompanists and a copy of the music for the judge.
4. Students may play repertoire which is not on the list or is out of print. The teacher must contact the committee chair for approval.

### **Rules for Concerto Audition, continued**

5. Students may play any repertoire, but must compete in their own school grade level. Students must play repertoire that is listed in their division or a higher division in order to win. Students may play repertoire at a lower level for evaluation only.
6. Traditionally, three entries from each of the three competition levels will be selected as finalists.
7. Honorable Mention awards will be given at the judges' discretion. Students performing for comments only are eligible for Honorable Mention.
8. A first place winner will be chosen from these levels:  
Elementary B; Intermediate and High School.  
(Elementary A will not compete, but plays for comments only)
9. The winner of the High School division will be named the overall winner and will perform with the Friends University Community Orchestra on their spring concert.
10. First place winners may not compete again for awards until they are eligible for the next division. They may play for comments.
11. **WMMTA policy:** WMMTA will pay up to \$400.00 for rental or purchase, which ever is the lesser cost, of orchestral parts for the high school winner's performance. **Any rental or purchase cost in excess of \$400.00 is the responsibility of the winner and/or his/her parents or guardian.**
12. It is the responsibility of the entrant to check the posted results of the preliminary auditions and to be present for the final audition if he/she is a finalist.
13. Teachers of the winning finalists form the Concerto Audition Committee for the following year. Traditionally, the teacher of the high school winner serves as chair.
14. Teachers of auditioning students will be expected to work at registration and as monitors on audition day.
